3. From Abigail's devotional, for whom were the good tidings that the angel brought the shepherds? **for all people**
4. When does the author of "Jesus, the Very Thought of Thee" ask Jesus to be our glory?  
**now and through eternity**
5. Who was the singer that accompanied D. L. Moody on his preaching tours? **Ira D. Sankey**
6. In "A Christmas Mistake," what came between Miranda Grant and Cornelia Millar, and how were they reconciled? **Gossip came between them; then they were reconciled after Mr. Palmer mistakenly invited the Grants to Christmas dinner with Miss Cornelia.**
7. The excerpt from Gary DeMar detailed two of the worst inflationary periods in modern history. In which nations did they take place? (Clue: One is in Europe and the other in North America.) **Germany and the United States\***
8. In the fable retold by R. J. Rushdoony, what trivial things did the peddler request after being transported to Heaven? **a hot cup of coffee and a doughnut**
9. Name one person or thing that "Road in Winter" said to behold. **a Child in the hay or a glorious day**
10. In "Carol" by William Canton, Jesus was described as "a rose of gold." Where did the poem say He dropped from? **God's own garden**
11. Why did King Wenceslas and his page venture out in the bitter cold? **to deliver food and wood to a peasant**

12. Where did the end of Abigail's song tell Mary to hold her Son though they would have to part on earth? ***in her heart***
13. When did Charlie, Bobwhite, and Hudson Brownlee study the Bible together? ***at dinnertime***
14. Whom did John Heedman want to see and be reconciled with before his death? ***his sister, Jane***
15. For what character trait was Charlie especially known as a man? ***punctuality***

**For discussion and for thought:**

1. How can we spread the joy of Christmas in our community and focus on giving rather than receiving? (See Matthew 10:42; Luke 2:15-17, 36-38; Acts 20:35; II Corinthians 9:6-15)
2. Charlie's besetting sin was procrastination. That means it was an area where he stumbled persistently. We can probably think of some besetting sins that *others* have, but what about identifying an area of temptation we fall into over and over again *ourselves*? Once we identify and repent of a particular sin, what can we do to keep from repeating it in the future? (See Psalm 19:12-14; Psalm 139:23-24; Romans 6:11-14; Hebrews 12:1-3)
